3. Old Business:
 - a. Don Lively updated the commission on the proposed blight ordinance. He is working on the Georgia Municipal Association's blight ordinance template and hopes to have it ready by the middle or end of October.
4. New Business:
 - a. Don Lively updated the commission on the following staff approved projects: 508 Jones Avenue, new porch flooring and columns. 709 Tucker Avenue, new roof of same material. 203 5th Street, new roof with same material. 834 Waters Street, replacement of nine rotted with new windows of similar design. 819 Academy Avenue, replacement of all windows with new windows of similar style and design. 504 Jones Avenue, replacement of old roof with architectural shingles.
 - b. Don Lively informed the commission about a city council request to officially change the historic district map to include the old Blakeney Elementary School building. A motion was made by Patricia Steele to make the change. Seconded by Kim Arrington. Approved.
